

STRAWBERRY PEAK IN OREGON ENDS

Government Estimates Year's Yield at About 18,000,000 Quarts

PORTLAND, Ore., June 27 (AP)—With the peak of the Oregon strawberry season at an end, government estimates place the year's yield at about 18,000,000 quarts.

As a matter of fact, it is probable that accurate figures will be available as many growers have not harvested their total crops for lack of a profitable market.

Packers have been compelled to notify growers holding contracts that they cannot receive additional berries until the storage temperature has been lowered to the required margin of safety.
