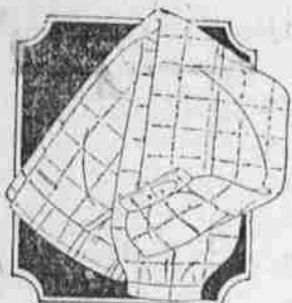

TWO ARMY FLYERS ARE HONORED IN HONOLULU TODAY

Recently, the two flyers were: the aviator aboard the main plane, and at the moment the hon- or was shared by Malind and Heisenberger. The two flyers were approximately 100 miles north of their intended course.

They first sighted, not Maui but the island of Kahoolawe. Being familiar with the Hawaiian Islands the flyers immediately oriented themselves and turned southward toward Oahu.

It was half an hour after Lindbergh and Heisenberger landed that the airplane was reported to have gone out to sea. It was found to be the fishing plane

already at rest on Wheeler field, surrounded by the military police, and the two aviators on the receiving stand receiving congratulations and telling how the longest trans-ocean air flight in history had been made.

Social functions for Malind and Heisenberger were absolutely "kapa" or forbidden yesterday in honor of them to get much needed rest. Late yesterday afternoon however they were unable to resist the lure of a plunge into the waters of Waikiki beach.

Crowd Assemblies Their appearance was the signal for the assembling of crowds that a score of motion picture and newspaper photographers and others. The two young aviators submitted good naturedly to the demands that they pose and finally returned to their hotel. Today however an active social

LOS ANGELES, June 29 (AP).—Dorothy Mackaye, wife of a convicted murderer, today awaited sentence in the draft box during the last session of the court. She is awaiting sentence for kidnapping a child, following her conviction yesterday of a "cover up" attempt in the death of her actor husband, Ray Raymond. Sentences will be passed upon the actress Saturday. The court has the choice of giving her an indeterminate sentence of from one to three years at San Quentin penitentiary, where he served her, Paul Kelly, in 1925, a one to ten-year term for manslaughter as a result of his fight with Raymond, or a substantial six-month imprisonment in the county jail.

Lindbergh, is expected to reach Pearson field here this afternoon at 2 p. m. He left San Francisco yesterday and stopped at Redding, Cal., over night.

APPOINTED TO COMMISSION

SALEM, Ore., June 30 (AP).—W. H. Fitzgerald, of Portland, was today appointed by Governor Paterson as a member of the state industrial accident commission to succeed William A. Marshall. Marshall resigned to accept a federal position as a deputy commissioner in charge of workmen's compensation for lumbermen and stevedores, with headquarters in Seattle. Fitzgerald has been deputy state labor commissioner for the last eight years in charge of the Portland office.

WASHINGTON, June 30 (AP).—

The secretary of war today approved the application of the Long Bell lumber company of Lodi, Wash., for the establishment of a combined pier head and bulkhead on the right bank of the Columbia river adjacent to Longview and resulting from the mouth of the Columbia river for about 7.5 miles to near the head of Fisher Island.
