Game Commission Frees Pheasants

PENDLETON, July 22 (AP)—The Eastern Oregon state game farm has liberated 2400 Chinese and Mongolian pheasants in Union, Baker, Umatilla and Gilliam counties. Due to the abundant amount of feed in this part of the state the birds are expected to thrive ex-

ceptionally well this year. Over 4,000 birds have been hatched at the game farm this year and other groups are to be liberated later. One hundred seventy-five turkeys will be released in the fall, according to officials.

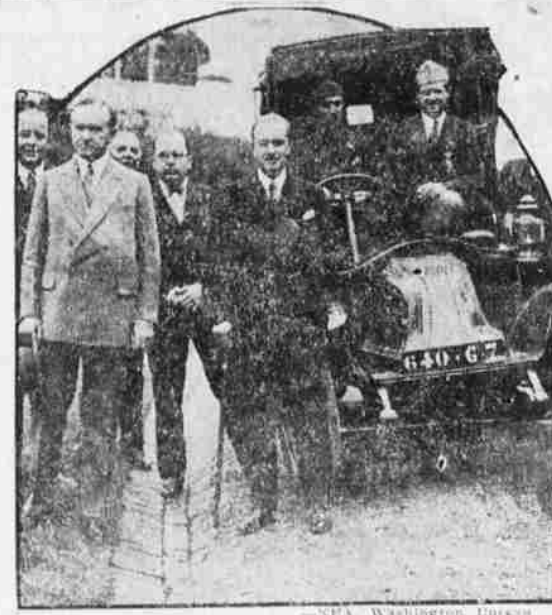
