## WILLYS-OVERLAND CONDITION GOOD

### New Car Stocks in Dealers' Hands Show a Decrease, Is Report

TOLEDO, N. J., July 22.—A report just issued by Willys-Overland for this city, shows general conditions among Willys and Overland dealers are showing the country to be in excellent shape.

New car stocks in dealers' hands at the end of June showed a decrease of 12.5 per cent as compared with the end of May. The total number of cars in dealers' hands at the end of June was 10,000, as compared with 11,400 at the end of May.

The report also shows that the number of cars sold in June was 1,500, as compared with 1,800 in May. This is a decrease of 16.7 per cent.



### Cities Survive Inside of Auto Capital, Detroit

DETROIT CAPS — Contrary to widespread belief, more than half the automobiles that are "made in Detroit" are really not made there at all.

It is a matter of fact that the city of Detroit has a number of automobile plants. Although they are entirely surrounded by Detroit, they have managed to remain in the city.

Within these two "island suburbs" are located large automobile plants. Highland Park is the original home of the Ford Motor company, from the last positions of which the largest revenue comes, and Hamtramck has the Dodge Brothers factories.

Neither suburb is more than a 25-minute ride from downtown Detroit. Detroit street cars run through both without extra charge to passengers, and strangers rarely learn that they have travelled from one city to another and then back to the first all in one continuous straight-ahead journey.

Hamtramck, though its light is concealed under Detroit's hood, is Michigan's fourth largest city, with a population of more than 70,000. Highland Park's 32,000 inhabitants enable it to seventh ranking annual cities of the state.
