

Farm Hard Times Is Reported By British Farmers

LONDON (AP)—British farmers, as well as American, have experienced difficult times during the past few years.

The average level of prices of agricultural produce is lower than in any year since 1915, says a report on the prices and supplies of agricultural produce and livestock.

Both fat cattle and fat sheep have fallen heavily in price. Fat pigs, on the other hand, are with those 1924-25 prices, and in view of the lower prices of feeding stuff.

The prices of fat pigs have proved remunerative. Milk has declined somewhat after being virtually stationary for three years, but has fallen steadily and cheese after showing an improvement in 1927-28, has fallen sharply to the low level of 22 percent above pre-war.
