### SPANISH MENACE LOSES ON FOUL

Paulino Waved to Corner  
in Seventh—Delaney  
Leads All the Way

NEW YORK, Aug. 12 (AP)—The Spanish menace to American heavyweight supremacy had drifted over theistic horizon today, temporarily at least, on the wings of an unsatisfactory and disputed fight as the Dempsey-Sharkey fight.

Paulino, but not greatly damaged by every blow known to the referee, the title threat of Paulino Escudon, wood chopper of the Pyrenees, faded when Jack Delaney's right hand was lifted in victory on a foul, after one minute and 27 seconds of fighting in the seventh of a 15-round fight at the Yankee Stadium last night.

Three warned by the referee for low punching, Paulino was waved to his corner after a fourth left hook landed below the belt. The result stunned the spectators, who had seen nothing untoward in the mulling, and left it to a controversy of "foul or no foul."

While the fracas lasted there was no question of supremacy. Returning to heavyweight ranks six months after his defeat by Jimmy McIntire, Paulino appeared Paulino at will, cut his face with a steady, though futile advance.

### Pick Stanford As Coast Grid King This Fall

EGGERS, Ore., Aug. 12 (AP)—University of Oregon and Oregon Agricultural college will finish no higher than sixth place in the coast conference football race, and Stanford university again will win the championship, in the opinion of three of the nine conference coaches, Hagshaw of Washington, Schmitter of O. A. C., and Erb of Idaho.

Believing that the Oregon line will be no stronger than last year, and in spite of her expected backfield reinforcements from the freshmen, Hagshaw has picked Oregon to finish in a tie for seventh with the Aggies, while Schmitter expects the Webfoots to finish seventh with the Aggies eighth, and Erb rates Oregon sixth with the Aggies seventh.
