BAVARIAN VETO TAX ON BACHELORS
BERLIN (AP)—Germany does not take kindly to Mussolini's idea of taxing bachelors. If the temper of the Bavarian legislature may be accepted as an indication of the feelings of all Germans.

When the Bavarian budget was brought into the diet recently, some member, in the hope of increasing the state's income, proposed a tax on bachelors similar to that decreed by Mussolini.

The minister of finance, opposing the suggestion, declared that the cost of determining the status of the tax in each case and the additional personnel required for enforcing its collection were out of all proportion to the results expected.

The diet sided with the minister and voted down the bill.
