A progressive little city of 1700 people, Union is the center of one of the most productive and important sections of the Grande Ronde valley. The community itself is known for its fine public spirit, for its activity in making Eastern Oregon's greatest stock show an annual event of wide interest, and for being the location of the state Agricultural Experiment Station and the state Fish Hatchery.

The Stock Show attracts people and exhibits each spring from all over this section of the Northwest. It is credited with having fostered and successfully encouraged the present interest in and demand for registered stock throughout the valley. In addition to being an aid to agriculture and stock raising, the show provides excellent entertainment during a three-day program. Stock featured at the show invariably ranks at the top in the Pacific International competition at Portland.

Surrounding Union is a rich agricultural country especially suited to fruit and vegetable growing, to dairying, as well as to general farming. Apples, prunes, cherries, berries, etc., of commanding quality are put on the market by Union growers. Dairying development is more obvious every year.

Union is particularly proud of its beautiful community-owned hotel, which is not only popular with hundreds of travelers but which also serves as a social center and gathering place for its home community and others throughout the valley. Adequate schools, churches, a good library, a progressive business district, etc., mark Union as a good city in which to live, as an attractive and interesting community to visit.
