Sea Fowl Rustling At American Falls

AMERICAN FALLS, Ida.—Observant naturalists in American Falls are remarking the curious circumstance that several varieties of sea fowl, normally inhabitants of the wind-swept beaches of the Pacific, are annually numerous along the Snake river this year. All summer long two species of salt water birds have frequented the waters below the American Falls dam, and now a third has made its appearance.

Early last spring flocks of sea gulls made the discovery that there was a fishing industry in the rough water below the dam. Stunned in descending the spillways, fish of various size would float helplessly down the channel, where they fell easy prey to the circling gulls.

For several weeks Mother Carey's chickens enjoyed a monopoly of the fishing industry, and then gray pelicans began to move in. They were followed by others, and at the present time it is not uncommon to see 75 or 100 swimming about in the lower channel.

WHEAT SUBSTITUTE

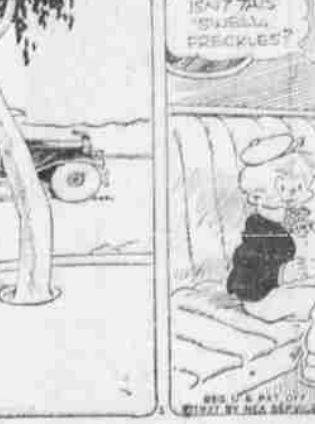
