GENE CERTAIN HE WILL KEEP TITLE

Champion is Confident of Knocking Dempsey Off Balance Early

LAKE VILLA, Ill. Sept. 21. (AP)—The self-made strategy that carried Gene Tunney to the heavy-weight throne in the battle of the semi-continent at Philadelphia last fall will guide the big marine in defense of his heavyweight crown against the former champion, Jack Dempsey, in Soldier Field Thursday night.

White around 150,000 spectators watch from the bleachers of the huge stadium as two gladiators battle for a purse of \$1,450,000. Tunney believes he will stay on a cutting left hand and hammer out just as decisive a victory with solid right crosses as he did in their first encounter a year ago. He hopes to complete Job.

Analyzing the situation calmly at the close of five months of training, Tunney says he should only be opportunely to complete the job left unfinished in the driving rain at Philadelphia. Although the champion shies at predicting a knockout victory, he believes that such an ending alone can establish the supremacy he feels over Dempsey.

Tunney's best chance for a knockout, he feels, probably will be one of the last three rounds, from the eighth to the tenth.

Gene will enter the ring pledged to no definite style of fighting, however.

"My plan of battle depends entirely on what Dempsey does, how he fights and the opportunities he throws in my path," he said. "I may nail him with a right smash to the chin in the first seconds of fighting as I did last September. If that happens Dempsey cannot evade a knockout this time.

"Money having nothing of speed and ability in a year's lay off from the ring.

In that year of almost constant training, Gene has built his fighting weight to 150 pounds and has stripped pounds from his hips and waist to add to the development of shoulders and arms.

Increases Punching Power
At the same time he has increased his speed, improved timing, judgment of distance and punching power. Many experts concede him at least a 20 per cent improvement over his ability and condition last year. The champion has developed a right to the heart or head that he believes will send Dempsey to the canvas.

"Tunney must prove that he can weather a storm of body punches such as Dempsey will crash to his heart and stomach.

"I am in the finest condition of my career, stronger, faster, and better all around than when I whipped Dempsey last fall," he said. "Jack cannot have improved all that in addition to the difference in our respective abilities last fall. I am going to win and by a far more decisive margin than at Philadelphia."

Jack Dempsey Expects to Knock Out Tunney Within First Seven Rounds

CHICAGO, Ill. (AP)—Jack Dempsey cut up under the bludgeoning Tuesday night for his sleep at his wind swept training camp confident that when he meets Gene Tunney in Soldier Field Thursday night he will win by a knockout within seven rounds.

The former world's heavyweight champion appeared to be in considerable shape Tuesday as he worked around camp, passing the time with his father, Hiram Dempsey, and other relatives who came from their lake to see, as they expressed it, "Jack" win back the title.

Dempsey's father brought with him Jack's neighbors, Lloyd Phillips. The other Dempsey's brothers, three from West Virginia, Hiram and Len Dempsey, Jack's cousin, Hiram Dempsey, and the Mayor of their lake, Clarence Neider, also joined the group. Mayor Neider flew from Salt Lake in an airplane to see the fight.

Hiram Dempsey, the Marine major's father, is certain that his famous son will conquer Tunney.

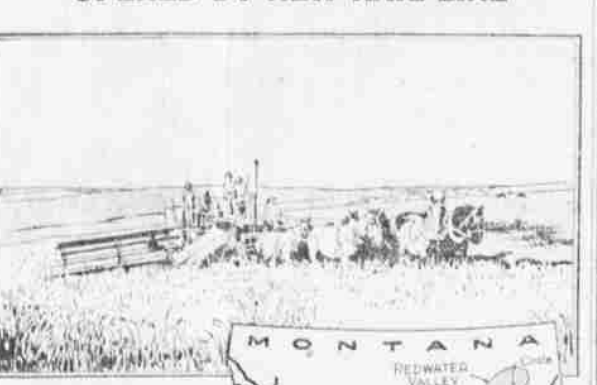

MONTANA'S RICH REDWATER VALLEY OPENED BY NEW RAIL LINE



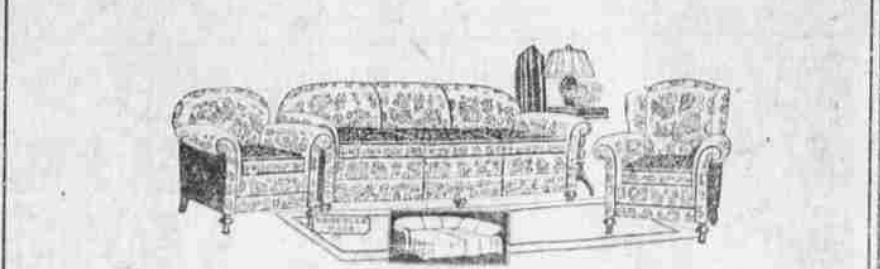
