Farm Pointers

Crop rotation is an effective in increasing soil fertility as the use of manure or commercial fertilizers. In a Missouri experiment corn yield 22.4 bushels an acre from cultivation alone 37.1 bushels when the field was manured and 37.5 bushels when grown in rotation with the clover. When both fertilization and rotation were practiced the yield was increased to 47.7 bushels.

Buckwheat has a characteristic, hard, black hull of practically no value as a feed. Unadulterated buckwheat middlings, which are difficult to obtain, are made from that part of the kernel just beneath the woody hull and are very rich in protein. The middlings usually are mixed with the hulls and sold as buckwheat feed or buckwheat bran. This product has a lower feeding value than wheat bran.

Often infectious diseases of hogs may be avoided through sanitation. No hog should be allowed to feed from dusty or muddy ground. Suitable feeding floors or platforms preferably of concrete, and troughs of some nonabsorbent material that can be cleaned, washed and disinfected frequently are recommended. Some sort of automatic drinking fountain which does not overflow should be used. If wallow holes are provided it is advisable to make them of concrete, so they may be cleaned and disinfected from time to time.

More of the constituents of milk are wasted or not well utilized in the manufacture of butter than in making any other dairy product. While there are not now ways of using all of this in a better way than through feeding to livestock, it will soon become necessary to use much more of it directly as food or otherwise dispose of it to better advantage.

When hogs of any age have constant access to self-feeders there is practically no danger of their overeating. This is of considerable importance in the case of sows which are suckling their litter.

The middle of a frozen pipe never should be thawed first. Work upward from the lower end, to permit the water to drain away.

Speaking of jubilees, it would be a pipe to organize one if you could guarantee that the rain was over for a few weeks.

The corn crop in the Middle West was a complete failure in July. The first of October finds it excellent in yield, well matured and out of danger of frost. It has ever been thus with the corn crop. Few people can remember when there was actually a corn crop failure but no one has difficulty remembering how dark are the prospects practically every year at some stage of the growing season. The weather isn't so much responsible as human nature. We are all prone to look and dwell upon the worst side of things. The losses are always remembered; the gains are seldom recognized. It could always be worse but we prefer to ponder and complain because it wasn't better. Averages aren't interesting. The perfect year is always sought for, always used as a standard of comparison. "It would have been wonderful, if..." The only consolation is that people who complain most usually continue to live, eat three meals a day, and act as though they enjoyed all actual and imaginary misfortune.

NO ECONOMY FOR THE MOTORIST

The \$3 license for motor vehicles does not gain popularity as car owners investigate it more thoroughly. Theoretically the idea of getting a car license for \$3 instead of paying \$15 to \$50 appeals to a large number of people. But the saving isn't as true as it appears and the car owner becomes the goat.

In California the auto license fee is low—but it doesn't represent a saving over the Oregon schedule. There, or in other states not requiring a license in reasonable relation to a property tax, a car owner must pay a personal property tax that equals or exceeds the Oregon license fee. A car costing \$600 would be assessed at not less than \$300, with a resulting tax at 6 per cent of \$18. To that would be added the \$3 license tax—\$21 paid for the privilege of owning a car under the three dollar system instead of about \$15 under our present plan. That doesn't spell economy to the average car owner.

Oregon's permanent highways are her greatest asset. They play a prominent part in her prosperity; in her growth, in her business and industrial activity, in her recreational needs, in all of the things that make Oregon outstanding. And it is the auto license money that has provided those highways. Without it, exorbitant gasoline taxes and increased property taxes would be necessary to carry on a like program. The entire structure of highway development—which means Oregon development—would be in danger with this auto license fund wiped out or greatly decreased.

Under our present system come car owners prefer to do without a car the first six months of the year, leave it in the garage unlicensed and save half of the fee. With a \$3 license in vogue and the car subject to property tax assessment the car owner would pay his tax regardless of when he ran his car. If the assessor failed to find the car and make the assessment, he escapes, but the fellow who pays sees his property taxes increase because of this new variety of tax dodger.

Paid petition circulators are going to be busy over Oregon the next few months with freak initiative petitions of this variety. They are a menace to Oregon's welfare and a double menace to the motorist they claim to benefit. The best way to protect the state against this \$3 license propaganda is to kill the petitions when they are circulated. Refuse to sign. Oregon wants no cheap license experiment.
