MENUS

BREAKFAST—Baked pears, boiled rice with chopped rabbits, cream, toasted graham rolls, creamed potatoes, broiled cottage ham, milk, coffee.

LUNCHEON—Cream of mislisy soup, croissants, cottage cheese and pepper sandwiches, boiled peach dumplings, grape juice.

DINNER—Lamb pie, creamed new turnips, honeydew and cheese ball salad, fresh plum pudding, milk, coffee.

Honeydew melon is cut in balls and marinated in French dressing for one hour. Cream cheese is combined with chopped nuts and

cliven and made into small balls and chilled for one hour. The melon balls and cheese balls are then served on lettuce with French dressing poured over the whole.

Lamb Pie
Sixteen small white onions, 1 1/2 cups diced cold roast lamb, 3 medium sized tomatoes, 1 teaspoon salt, 1/4 teaspoon pepper, 1 tablespoon butter, 1 tablespoon flour, baking powder biscuit dough.

Peel onions and cook, uncovered, in slightly salted boiling water until tender but not broken. Drain and put into a buttered baking dish. Remove meat from lamb bone. Cover bone with cold water and bring slowly to the boiling point. Simmer for 20 minutes. There should be 1/2 cup of broth. Cover onions in baking dish with meat and cover

HYACINTHS IN THE HOUSE
No plant is so easily managed for winter bloom in the house and so sure of giving ample return for the care given it as the hyacinth. Nothing is more satisfying in the way of color and fragrance. Now is the time to plant bulbs for winter bloom in the house and so sure of giving ample return for the care given it as the hyacinth.

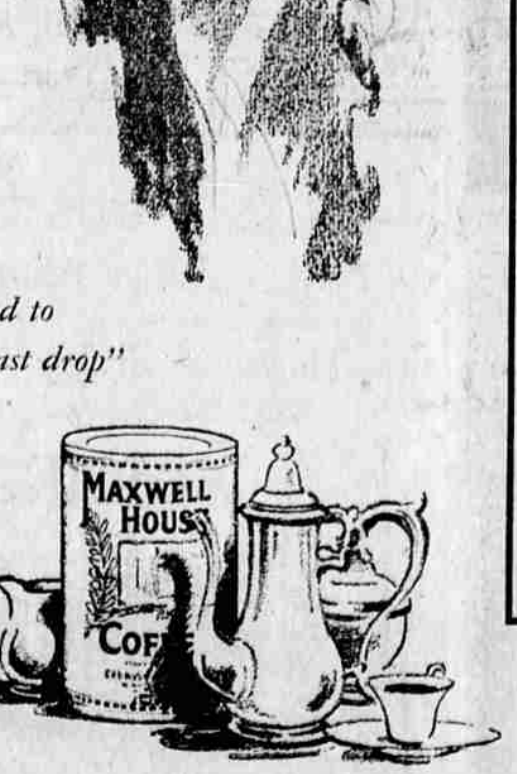
After being potted up, the pots may be buried under a bed of ashes or boards with five or six inches of soil above them until freezing weather sets in, one of the most satisfactory starts, or they may be set away in a dark closet or cellar while the bulbs make roots. They will start active top growth in from six to eight weeks. When the blunt nose is pushed well out of the bulb, bring them to the light but do not give them full light until

ter display. A five-inch pot for a good-sized bulb is about the right size. Give broken crock for drainage, press the soil firmly about the bulb, the crown of the bulb being just above the level of the soil and the soil half an inch from the top of the pot to give room for liberal watering.

After being potted up, the pots may be buried under a bed of ashes or boards with five or six inches of soil above them until freezing weather sets in, one of the most satisfactory starts, or they may be set away in a dark closet or cellar while the bulbs make roots. the flower-like spike is well through the neck of the bulb. A little weak manure water will help at this stage. Growing the fibres in bowls is another popular method and an attractive one. The prepared fibre will absorb a lot of moisture and it should be well moistened with rain water until saturated before being placed in the bowls. It will take several days to do this.
