Cops Raid Cabin And Make Arrest

SPOKANE, Oct. 6. (AP)—In response to a telegram from the sheriff of Jackson county, Oregon, police raided a tourist cabin camp here, and found Walter Livengood, blind perfume peddler, with three women, a 14-year-old girl, an eight-year-old boy and an 18-year Spokane youth. The Oregon officials had been particularly anxious for the detection of the girl whose last name is Simpson. She is being held today in the juvenile detention rooms pending the arrival of Oregon officers.

The women and the girl insisted yesterday that their relations with Livengood were entirely proper. They said they had been employed to sell such perfume. The eight-year-old boy was turned over to juvenile authorities and no charges have been preferred against Livengood or the women.
