Vegetables And Fruits in Demand In Portland Mart

PORTLAND, Nov. 7 (AP)—Most dealers in the Portland wholesale market for vegetables and fruits and vegetables were favored with a good volume of trade at the week's opening Monday morning. Little new was being offered but plentiful supplies of current lines were getting fair demand at about steady prices.

A new offering of clean and solid Brussels sprouts, grown near Greenham, was quoted at \$1.25 per 10-pound flat.

Sweet potatoes were getting increasingly good action and sold slightly higher at 3 1/4¢ per pound in many instances.

Grapes in several varieties were in strong supply at steady prices with demand steady for limited amounts.

Butter and egg prices remain unchanged over the week-end, but market tone is viewed as easier for the beginning of the new week.

All lines of country dressed meats and poultry opened the week steady with Saturday's quotations but dealers were faced with cleaning up a sizeable Sunday carry-over of veal.

Besides veal receipts were the heaviest in the meat line, but dealers were optimistic for the price to hold up.

CHICAGO, Nov. 7 (AP)—Opening 3/4 to 1/2 down, Chicago wheat sagged a little further and then rose to 1/2 above Saturday's finish.

Corn was strong, starting unchanged to 1/2 higher and subsequently climbing all around. Oats were firm. Provisions tilted upward.

Wheat closed nervous, at the same as Saturday's finish to 3/4 higher; corn 3/4 to 1 1/2¢; oats showing 1/4 to 3/4¢ advance and provisions unchanged to a rise of 15¢.

Stock Recovery Continues Today In Wall Street

NEW YORK, Nov. 7 (AP)—The recovery in stock prices which set in last week, was continued today with the demand stimulated by the favorable interpretation placed by most Wall Street observers on the terms of the new government financing. Business orders was distributed over a broad list with gains in the active issues running from 1 to 6 points.

A strong undertone was apparent for the high grade industries, although U. S. Steel common ran into a little selling after crossing 137, American Tobacco issues again established new record high levels while among the many issues to cross their previous 1927 peaks were R. H. Macy, Curley Co., Bucyrus Adding Machine, Central Leather, American Inland, Kennecott Copper and Warren Bros.

The sudden drop in temperature brought fresh buying into the east-coasters with Lackawanna and Delaware and Hudson in the forefront of the advance. The so-called "merger roads" also were in brisk demand under leadership of Washington common, Western Maryland, Gulf Mobile and Northern and Kansas City Southern.

The closing was strong. All classes of stocks participated in the forward movement in the final hour which carried a number of high priced shares up four to six points, including American Smelting, Houston Oil, U. S. Cast Iron Pipe, Case Threshing Machine, Lackawanna and Delaware and Hudson. Nash Motors was the strongest of the moderate priced issues. Total sales approximated 1,300,000 shares.
