Allen Smears Idaho Scrapper in Main Event—Semi-Final a Draw

GENERAL FLEES; HANKOW IN PANIC

Tang Seng-Chi, Commander of Nationalists, En Route for Japan

HANKOW, Nov. 12 (AP)—General Tang Seng-Chi, commander of the Hankow nationalist troops, took flight from Hankow this morning. It was reported that he was aboard a Japanese steamer bound for Japan.

Panic reigns in the city. Many persons have been injured in clashes but no deaths have been reported.

A tense situation exists. The city is disorganized as there is no one in command. The advancing Nanking nationalists are expected to arrive tomorrow. The Chinese are flocking into the concession area and barricades have been erected around the French concession.

General Tang Seng-chi's troops are proceeding toward Chungshu, apparently in an endeavor to recapture the city which has unexpectedly fallen into the hands of troops from Hankow.

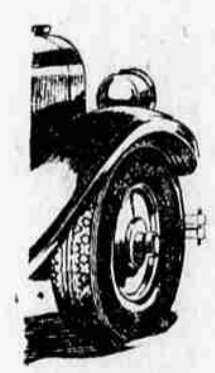
