SPOKANE (AP)—The path of glory has led but to financial grief for Tom O'Brien, 77-year-old Indian fighter famed for his one-man parades.

O'Brien decided that the Civil and World War veterans who monopolized the spotlight with their processions and pageantry, so he set out to commemorate the courage of the northwestern Indian fighters by holding an annual one-man parade in full regalia.

On yearly occasions of state O'Brien donned his blue uniform, covered with decorations and topped by a plume hat garnished with peacock feathers.

Thousands of people turned out to see him ride astride his white horse, with a pillow attached to his saddle for comfort. But the cost of country badly bent his little fortune, the product principally of his pension as a one-time member of the Second Infantry. Now he has announced that he will enter the Old Soldier's home at Orling, Wash. The day of the one-man parade, even for the glory of the days of Indian fighting, he says, is now a thing of the past.

HOW HIGH IS HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE?

What may be high blood pressure for one person may not be high for another. For this reason it is very difficult to estimate tables of average pressure that will be of any particular value in telling if one's blood pressure is high.

There are times and conditions in which persons must be able to run their blood pressure high in order to maintain health, or at least to live and carry on. The warrior, the poet, the lover cannot be expected to maintain a placid pulse and be a warrior, a poet, or a lover. One should be able to return to placidity, of course, but he should be able to flare up if the occasion demands.

Then, too, an increasing pressure is sometimes a necessity. As you advance, there inevitably occurs a thickening of the arterial walls. The heart must increase its force in pushing the blood stream out and on through the arteries. In these cases if there has not been an increase in the blood pressure the heart has become too weak to increase it.

A so-called "normal" pressure in these cases indicates disease rather than health.

These remarks are made because blood-pressure instruments are being used carelessly, incorrectly, and sometimes fraudulently to frighten patients. Patients themselves are beginning to apply blood-pressure instruments to their own arms to estimate their own pressure and are often alarmed unwarrantedly. Several checks must be applied to the tests to make them at all valid.

than "how high is low?"

So do not let anybody take your blood pressure who is not thoroughly competent to take it; who will not take sufficient pains to take it correctly, and who will not be thoroughly honest about estimating its importance in your particular case.

One should know, if his pressure should not be relatively high. He should know if the pressure returns to normal soon after necessary exertion has caused it to rise.

Moreover, it is just as necessary for you to know whether the low point of pressure (diastolic pressure) is too low or too high as it is for you to know whether the high point of pressure (the systolic pressure) is too high or too low. For the diastolic pressure has to do with the elasticity of the vessel walls. And the elasticity of the vessel walls has to do with the circulation of the blood in the capillaries where the nutrition of the tissues takes place. "How high is high" is thus not more important
