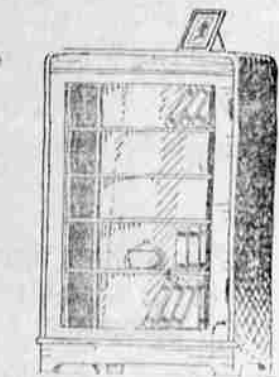
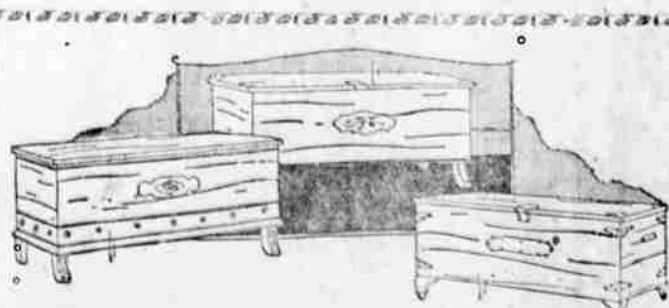

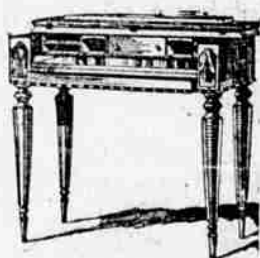

SAN FRANCISCO, Dec. 2. (AP)—Captain Frederick A. Giles, British aviator, announced today he had recommended to W. J. Ross, warner of Detroit, his financial backer, that the proposed flight from San Francisco to New Zealand be postponed until next spring.

Only \$13,377,466 In U. S. Treasury

WASHINGTON, Dec. 2. (AP)—The government was theoretically and comparatively "hard up" today, with a mere \$13,377,466.98 on tap at the treasury, the smallest sum in ten years.

Treasury officials explained that the low net balance was of no significance and was only a bookkeeping proposition because they could always raise large sums on brief notice by issuing short term certificates.
