## Urges Action On Baby Chicks In Supreme Court

WASHINGTON, Dec. 12 (AP)—Prompt classification of baby chicks is being urged upon the supreme court. The highest tribunal has been asked by an incubator company in California to hasten a decision declaring that poultry when shipped in interstate commerce is exclusively under federal control, under laws relating to shipment of cattle and other livestock.

The case seeks to set aside regulations in Oregon, Washington and Idaho prohibiting bringing into those state of newly hatched chicks unless shipments are accompanied by certificates from state officials showing they are free from certain hereditary poultry diseases.

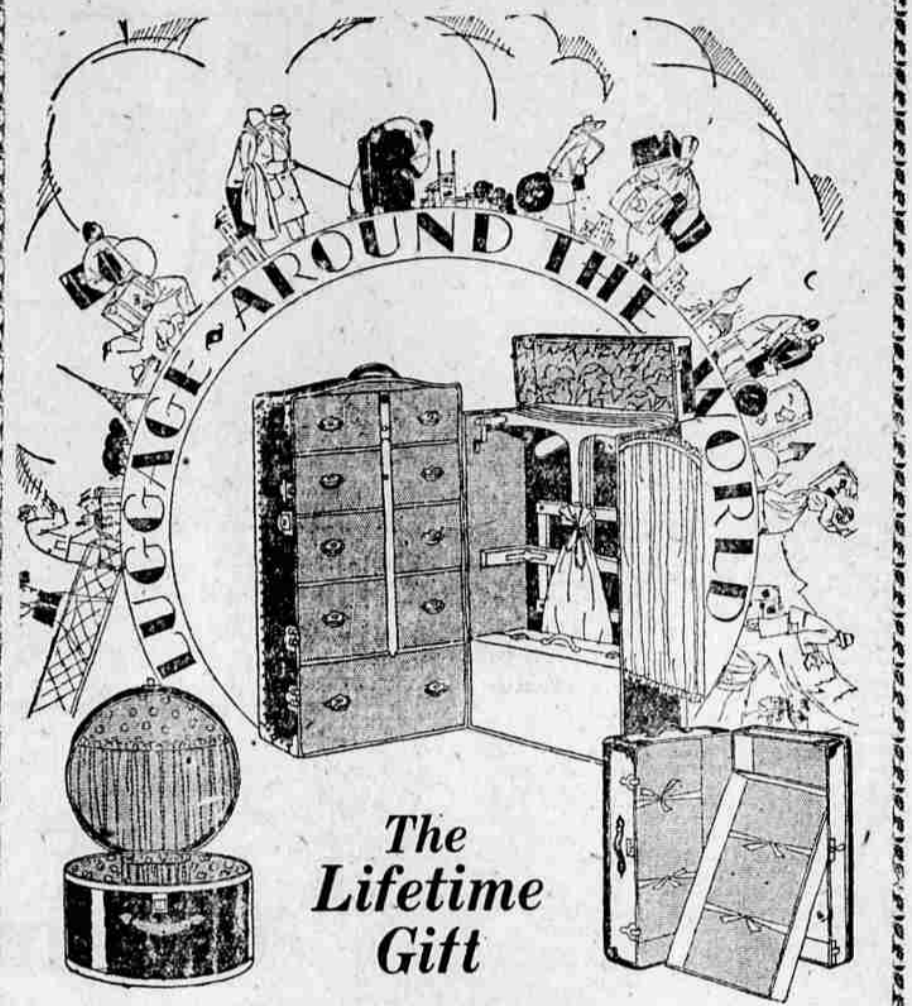
