

Farm Pointers

As the alfalfa seed crop is somewhat smaller this year, it will be well for Oregon farmers to anticipate planting needs and lay in a supply of Grima seed. The Canadian variegated crop which normally goes to the east is reduced this year, reports the experiment station, and this may make a stronger demand on the western strain.

Oregon standard potato seed

made an excellent production record in California this year. It is much better than common seed but is meant for commercial planting rather than for certification work. Standard seed is good seed for those who buy surplus each year or every other year, say experiment station men.

Ornamental trees and shrubs frequently become infested with San Jose scale and other scale insects. These pests are controlled by spraying with the standard lime sulfur solution or oil emulsion. Lime sulfur 12-100 is probably the best spray to use. The house gardener will find many helpful hints for the control of in-

sects. In experiment station circles, "Insect Pests of Truck and Garden Crops." It will be mailed free on application to the state college experiment station.

Now is a good time to clean seed for spring planting. All dirt, chaff and weed seeds are best removed from seed grain. The ordinary flanning mill which is found on most farms will clean grain satis-

factorily for seed purposes. It pays for to sow clean seed.

The litter in living houses on successful Oregon poultry farms is changed whenever it becomes damp, whether that is one week or once every two weeks.

Potatoes treated with corrosive sublimate, the recommended treatment in Oregon, should be treated while still dormant or before they have sprouted. Badly sprouted potatoes if treated are given a shorter dip, or treated by some other method.

Larger Lamb Crop Needed in Oregon

"One of the big problems of the sheep business in this state is that the breeders are not getting a large enough lamb crop," says H. A. Lindgren. "The state of Washington reports an average of 120 per cent lambing while the average for this state is only 80 to 90 per cent. More attention must be paid to breeding and lambing time. Ewes giving a large amount of milk and having a good heavy fleece with lots of quality together with conformation is what makes the sheep pay."

"This state has very good marketing conditions for both sheep and cattle providing they are handled correctly. Oregon is strictly a lamb-raising state. Idaho and Washington are looking to this state for fine wool breeding stock, thus affording an excellent market for breeding ewes. In Portland the market demands 2500 head of cattle per week which can be supplied by breeders of this state providing their cattle are put on the market regularly in good condition, which is possible."

Steers fattened during the winter months on alfalfa hay make very profitable gains, the Oregon experiment station finds. Hay-fattened cattle are desirable for beef in the northwest, as in this way they are always ready for the early spring market when prices are the highest.

The practice of culling the sheep flock according to the weight and quality of fleece per sheep has greatly increased the wool production according to extensive investigations by the college extension service. This is a simple process but increases profits markedly.

Timbermen Evolve Plan To Save Three Million Trees Each Year

MADISON, Wis. (AP) — Three millions young hardwood trees will be saved yearly if plans evolved by the first class of active loggers and rangers ever to attend a university course in timberland management are put into practice.

The course was given by the University of Wisconsin and included inspection trips into woods where new logging methods already are in operation.

Studies revealed an urgent need

for selective logging and timber conservation, and led to adoption of a resolution making that the interstate commerce commission require railroads to equip cars designed for transportation of logs with mechanical devices so as to eliminate the use of young timber for car stakes. In the three states of Wisconsin, Minnesota and Michigan six million car stakes are used each year in the transportation of logs. This results in the

destruction of about 2,000,000 hardwood trees a year that are the most thrifty and the straightest young growing timber in the forests.

The class made it emphatic that to destroy this potential hardwood supply at such an early stage not only is wasteful and uneconomic, but directly opposed to sound conservation practice.

New taxation plans for encouraging the growth of future timber supplies were stimulated by the course.
