TURKEY TRADERS NOT SO CERTAIN

Not Sure Whether Market
Will Break Sharply or
Remain Steady

PORTLAND, Dec. 19 (AP)—Whether the local turkey market is about to break sharply down or to break a new record is a question which local poultry raisers and commission men are unable to answer. The turkey market is decidedly weak with few offerings being made. The market is being held by a few large buyers in the market. In some quarters it is feared that prices will be down considerably unless demand increases substantially in the near future. It is expected that prices will increase steadily until after the holidays.

Other classes of poultry are holding steady, although a sharp decline is not out of the question. Country dressed meats are firm with the exception of slightly easier prices in the hog division. Live light hogs are moving easily around \$15.00. Yearlings are steady around \$17.50.

Butter and egg prices are unchanged with flour in good demand. The butter market is a little unsettled with most buyers offering 50¢ per pound, although some offerings can be had as high as 52¢.
