PORTLAND, Ore., Dec. 22 (AP)—Considerable buying on the part of retailers has tended to keep the local turkey market steady around 27 to 28c for best stock. Although accumulation of receipts last night was rather heavy supplies are moving out in good volume and appearances this morning were that the market would clean up fairly well today. Dealers are still a bit hesitant to forecast what prices will prevail the next few days, however, as it is reported that raisers are holding large stocks which may come in in such heavy volume as to glut the market and send prices downward.
