Icy Streets In Portland Add to Travel Trouble

PORTLAND, Ore., Jan. 4. (AP)—Freezing temperatures last night following rain and "thaw," created snowy streets and sidewalks with ice this morning, adding to transportation difficulties following the severe storm of New Year's.

In outlying districts motor driving and walking was perilous, but in the downtown areas where crews have been removing snow, conditions were much better.

Trains, except on the blizzard section of the Oregon-Washington Railroad and Navigation line between Portland and Hood River, were moving on schedule. The O. W. R. and N. continued to route its trains over the Spokane, Portland and Seattle railway tracks, on the north bank of the Columbia. Determined efforts were being made today to clear away the wreck that had blocked the O. W. R. and N. line since Sunday. A relief train reached the wreck late yesterday bringing in the body of fireman J. W. Wark, who died from injuries and members of the train crew who had been held in the wreck since the snow blockade.

Continued moderation in the weather, with occasional rain was the forecast for Oregon.
