### PROCRUSTINATION IN CANCER MEANS SUICIDE

Cancer is on the increase, not only in the United States, but everywhere.

Why, we do not know fully, but we do know a great deal about cancer which if put into practice by men and women, would do much to reduce the number of deaths from this disease.

Cancer never tends to cure itself. Its start and progress in early stages are insidious—it is a crafty foe and seldom gives any pain in the beginning.

The best chance for cure is in the early stage. Late cancer is well nigh incurable. Cancer affects people of old age and middle age mostly. That is why men and women of 40 and more must be continually on guard.

The female breast is a frequent site for cancer, and many women innocently commit suicide by procrastination after they discover a lump in the breast, allowing it to progress until the disease has spread too far to be eradicated.

Experience and experiment have taught that when a lump or sore spot or any other unnatural condition in the breast first calls a woman's attention to that organ, that is the time to have it thoroughly examined by a competent and painstaking physician. I don't mean next week or next month, but right then.

A cancer cannot be attacked too early. If, after examination, the

patient cannot be assured positively that no cancer exists. It must be regarded as present.

Often the first intimation of tumor of the breast is detected accidentally, though women should be on the alert for the discovery of lumps all the time. Usually at the time of discovery the lump is the size of a hazel nut. It may grow very slowly or it may suddenly take on fresh growth. For a time it usually remains located some distance under the skin. When moderately advanced it approaches and becomes attached to the skin. Up to the time of this attachment its cure is much simpler than later on. Every delay adds to the seriousness of the situation.

After the discovery of a lump, don't delay a single day. Following this simple advice will save many lives, perhaps your own. In cancer delay is fatal.
