Tom Tyler At Colonial Theater Today

Beery and Hatton Score Again in "Wife Savers"

Wallace Beery and Raymond Hatton in their fifth joint appearance in "Wife Savers", which will be the attraction at the Arcade theater for three days starting Thursday return to American army uniform in which they made their debut as a comedy team. "Behind the Front" was the picture that introduced this pair, now recognized as the greatest duo of laugh provokers the world has ever enjoyed.

The army uniform is quickly doffed by Beery in this opus. Kennedy manipulates various politics so that a false proclamation is issued requiring all women to marry within 24 hours. He is foiled, however, when Sally insists on marrying Wally. Wally finds himself married to his lieutenant's girl, with the lieutenant on the way back to France to claim her. Of course it works out so that neither Hatton, Kennedy nor Beery get the girl in the end. But in squaring the triangle some of the most hilarious comedy ever screened has been introduced. Some of the effects for laugh-getting are spectacular, including snowslides and landslides, falls over cliffs and howling blizzards.

GOTTER AND NERVOUSNESS

Member Gorges Memorial Gotter is a disease, usually an overactivity of the thyroid gland in the front of the neck. This gland is beyond doubt intimately concerned with the physical expression of the emotion of fear. Producing eye-balls, trembling limbs, and rapid heart, three of the cardinal symptoms of this disease, are typical symptoms of extreme fright, so that it seems safe to state that this emotion produces its characteristic physical signs by producing overaction of the thyroid, particularly since it is common experience that persons with diminished thyroids are dull and lack emotion. For these reasons it is natural that a person living in terror might so plainly show protruding eyes, trembling limbs, and rapid heart as to be mistaken for one with overaction of the thyroid. Fortunately there is a very accurate and easy chemical test which will separate the true cause of thyroid disease from that which shows some of its symptoms as a result of continuous anxiety over personal difficulties. This test is called the Basal Metabolic Rate. It depends on the fact that one of the duties of the thyroid gland is to regulate the amount of oxygen consumed by the body. The test meas-
