SENSITIVE NESS

McLean's Early Adventures Linked With Founding of Settlements Here

Today is given the second and last installment of the fascinating pioneer history of "Dunc" McLean, of Wallowa, as it appeared from the pen of the Hamstreet's of Wallowa. Having contained so many references to early days in this valley, and to names familiar to many residents of this county, the story has been greatly appreciated, we have been told.

"Ben Brown, who already has been referred to as founder of La Grande had been in the train with the McLeans in crossing the plains, but instead of going on to The Dalles, he had stopped on what is now the site of Old Town, La Grande, and erected the first house, which he made a sort of trading headquarters."

"Soon after leaving, Dunc's father tried his hand at a little freighting. Dunc recalls one trip he made with a team and wagon from Umatilla to Owyhee, with 2500 pounds of vitrol, for which he received 35 cents a pound, freight."

"Settlement in Grande Ronde Valley became quite lively along during those days and the Iowa settlement sprang up, a settlement near the present town of Island City. John, Dunc's brother, was the first teacher in the settlement, but he died during the first term. His sister, Belle, was taken into the home of Dr. Hulsey, received an excellent education and later married William Lockwood and resided in Baker for a number of years. Both are now deceased. Two children survive, Mrs. Edward O'Brien and Claude Lockwood, both of La Grande."

"Young Maggie received her early schooling in La Grande, graduating from the Old Blue Mountain University, and later attended the sisters' school at Baker. She then began a notable career as teacher in Eastern Oregon, later marrying John McDonald, pioneer of Eastern Oregon, and now a resident of Wallowa. Mrs. McDonald is now deceased."

"As soon as was old enough, Dunc left home and hit it off for the placer mines where the big excitement lured him. But he recollected some schooling obtained in Summerville before he left, with Levi J. Rouse his father teacher and John Johnson, father of the Johnson boys now residents here, his Sunday school teacher. In fact it was at Summerville that Ernest and Arthur Johnson were born. While a Sunday school boy at Summerville, in 1863, Dunc made his first trip to Portland to attend a Sunday school convention."

"As he traveled from one mining camp to another, over Eastern Oregon and into Idaho, Dunc had to work for wages, as he was too young to mine on his own. Trying to get to Idaho City one time, he managed to get as far as Boise, 35 miles away, and there he was stranded.
