

HICKMAN SANITY TRIAL NEAR END

Last of State Witnesses Is Expected to Give Testimony This Afternoon

LOS ANGELES, Feb. 8 (AP)—With a quick-time march of final witnesses, the sanity trial of William Edwards Hickman today moved into its final stages. Attorneys for both sides predicted that the last of the evidence for and against the youth's insanity plea to the kidnapping and murder of Little Marjorie Parker would be placed before the jury before the end of today's session. They said it was possible that the jury would hear the final arguments of attorneys and begin its deliberations by tomorrow night.

With the opening of the final scenes of the sensational case it was disclosed that virtually none of the principals in the trial drama had escaped the attacks of the writers "crazed" letters.

Jury Receives Letters

The latest target for threatening missives is the jury itself. Its members, however, were kept ignorant of the letter which had been received threatening to "blow the whole bunch up" if Hickman was not held "responsible" for the school girl's murder.

The letter, addressed to "the Hickman jury" was intercepted by the court clerk and turned over to Judge J. J. Trabucco and the authorities for investigation. It was declared the work of some unbalanced person—a type also blamed for threatening letters received in numbers by Judge Trabucco, District Attorney A. K. Koyen and his aides, as well as the members of the defense counsel.

Alleged End Testimony

The last of the state witnesses, all of whom have declared Hickman sane in the sense that he was able to distinguish between right and wrong, completed their testimony yesterday.

During the cross examination of Dr. Thomas J. Orblison, one of these expert witnesses, the defense managed to slip into the record Hickman's "closing argument" prepared by the young slayer himself in his cell for delivery at his trial. The admission of a copy of that oration, titled by its young author "Solution of crime," had been barred previously on a prosecution objection that it was "too myopic."

The Hickman document was dismissed by other state attorneys as the plea of a man "at the end of his rope."

Dr. Orblison was asked to examine it to determine whether it contained any evidence of insanity. The alienist labeled it "merely a sophomoric essay on crime."

Burn Exhibition

Dr. Edward H. Williams, the last of the prosecution attorneys, testified yesterday that Hickman was "obviously feigning insanity," and making a "burn exhibition" of it. "He is faking and doing it clumsily," the doctor continued.

As the brain experts completed their analysis of Hickman for the jury, ordinary folk received a chance to give their opinions. In rapid order, four employees of the Los Angeles bank in which Hickman worked until he took up check forging; a former fellow student of the defendant in a Kansas city high school; two residents of Alhambra, a suburb, and a police officer, all of whom had known the youth, were called to testify. All said they considered Hickman sane.

Hunt Testifies

Wayne Hunt, Hickman's confessed accomplice in a holdup attempt that resulted in the death of C. Ivy Thomas, a druggist, testified that Hickman was sane to all his knowledge.

Judge Rudlong, a fellow inmate in the county jail told from the witness stand how the latter slipped him a "fits letter" previously entered into the court records. The letter announced Hickman's intention of staging a "creaming, laughing, diving act" to impress the jury.

Rudlong denied that he had been "planted" in Hickman's cell to obtain damaging evidence against him. He said he had not turned the letter over to the authorities but that a deputy sheriff had seen the missive handed to him and had taken it away from Rudlong.

Perry to be Witness

At the close of court yesterday the prosecution said the only witness remaining to be called were a Los Angeles officer, the two Pendleton, Ore., officers who arrested Hickman, the county attorney, A. E. Wagner and Perry M. Parker, father of the slain girl.

The defense said it would have only one rebuttal witness—Dr. A. S. Skoog, Kansas City alienist, who testified earlier in the trial he believed Hickman insane.
