Butter and Egg Prices Steady As Week Opens

PORTLAND, Ore., Feb. 12 (AP)—Butter and egg prices were steady on local markets today, although a weak market is reported in the market and receipts from country points are large.

A new car of Roseburg broccoli arrived today, making four carloads which have reached the local produce market so far this season.

Good celery is in fair supply, with prices ranging from \$1.25 to \$1.50 a dozen for large stalks.

Spinach is quite scarce. A little is coming in from The Dalles and is of unusually fine quality.

Government Wins Victory in Court

WASHINGTON, Feb. 12 (AP)—The government won a victory today when Justice Frederick L. Phillips upheld its objection to testimony intended to show that the United States authorities had shadowed trial jurors for which offense Harry F. Sinclair, William J. Burns, and three associates are being tried for criminal contempt of court.

Defense counsel pleaded the testimony would show Sinclair in employing the detectives had acted in good faith in following a government custom. They also argued they had the "right to show by evidence what usage and custom was."

12 Rebels Slain In Mexican Fight

DIES OF HEART DISEASE

He came to Washington in 1882, establishing the Spokane Falls Herald, which later was consolidated with the Spokesman, forming the Spokesman-Review.

Sandino Is Still In Own Country

MANAGUA, Nicaragua, Feb. 12 (AP)—Advisers available in Nicaragua today indicate that a report received in the United States that Augustino Sandino, Nicaraguan rebel leader, is fleeing to Honduras, is unfounded.

Sandino, who has been operating in Nueva Segovia, a northern department of Nicaragua, for the past six months, two weeks ago slipped southeast from his former stronghold of El Chipote to San Rafael del Norte. He remained there a few days and appeared at several coffee plantations in the vicinity of the city of Matagalpa.

Murderer Shot As He Tried Suicide

TOPEKA, Kans., Feb. 12 (AP)—After slaying his wife with a revolver, shooting his 12-year-old son and attacking two other members of his family with a butcher knife when they sought to interfere, Ed Schmidt, a former restaurant proprietor, attempted suicide but was shot and killed by a policeman today when he resisted arrest. The injured are expected to recover.
