

Agricultural Outlook Given In U. S. Report

The U. S. department of agriculture has issued this month a carefully prepared bulletin of 52 pages giving the agricultural outlook for 1928 and covering every line of farm industry. The following summary is made up therefrom regarding the crops in which Oregon people are mostly interested:

Wheat—Outlook uncertain, depending on weather results and subsequent yield.

Flax—Flax acreage can be expanded profitably to replace other spring grains in the same area.

Oats—Likely to meet less favorable market.

Beet—Beet acreage reasonably certain to meet a market that will average higher than 1927, though may not reach high peak of 1927.

Hops—Prices likely to show some strengthening. Some improvement in domestic demand is anticipated.

Sheep and wool—The outlook for wool growers appears favorable.

Goats—Mohair producers have much better prospects than in 1927.

Poultry—Favorable prospects. Small storage holdings on hand.

Potatoes—Any increase in acreage is liable to make low prices.

Apples—Nothing to discourage commercial growers who are favorably located.

WHAT IS BLOOD PRESSURE?

The taking of the blood pressure of individuals has been rather an ordinary procedure during the past 25 years. Previous to 1900 this was not a common practice. Today the value of blood pressure is definitely recognized and plays an important role in the diagnosis of disease and in the appraisal of the general condition of the patient.

Blood pressure implies the force or pressure of the circulating blood within the arteries of the body. It is in these vessels that the blood is contained and circulated. As it does so it exerts pressure against the vessel walls. The physician estimates two forms of blood pressure—a systolic and a diastolic. The systolic pressure is the greatest force within the circulation and exists at the moment of the heart contraction or so-called systole. The diastolic blood pressure is the lowest force in the circulation and exists during the moment of completed heart rest or diastole. The difference between the two is called the pulse pressure. Save good dairy calves and call your herds to retain only your best stock.
