Bebe Daniels Triumphs With "Feel My Pulse"

If one likes good, clean, fast moving comedy for their motion picture entertainment, the place to get it today and Tuesday is at the Arcade theater.

Bebe Daniels, Paramount star, makes the effort. And a beautiful player really outdoes herself in her latest screen offering, "Feel My Pulse."

These are just a few of the situations which suit Miss Daniels' talents perfectly. And she makes the best of her opportunities.

Miss Daniels plays the role of a beautiful American girl who has been brought up with the idea that she is a frail thing when in reality there is nothing the matter with her. She visits a sanitarium, left her by an uncle, a health crank, and finds it in possession of a bootlegging gang.

"Hit the Deck" Acclaimed by Show Critics

"Hit the Deck" declared by critics over the country to be the greatest show of the year, will appear in two performances at the Clark theater on Baker Sunday, March 25. Seat sale already has been started and it is expected that capacity houses for both performances will be assured within a few days. There will be a 2:30 matinee, and the show at night will start at 8:30.

"Hit the Deck" is a merry musical show with lots of whistling tunes, plenty of snappy dances and oodles of clever lines, hit the town when the girls and the girl friends simply took the port of Portland by firing only two rounds—a round of melody and a round of melody.

"If you don't know the opening reference, 'Hallelujah,' you just don't know the greatest song that 'Hit the Deck' on the theatrical map; it is the song that will keep it there.
