MONOPLANE STILL HELD BY WEATHER

Bremen Rocks in Irish
Gale Instead of Soaring
Across the Atlantic

RAIDONNEE AIRDRONE, Dublin, Mar. 29 (AP)—The Junkers monoplane Bremen, lashed to the earth with ropes and its wheels blocked by empty gasoline cans, rocked in an Irish gale today instead of soaring across the Atlantic.

Weather conditions here were almost as bad as those reported from the middle of the Atlantic and the American coast. Baron Ehrenfried Guther von Huenefeld, backer of the trans-Atlantic flight, hoped to get off at dawn. His pilot, Captain Hermann Koehl and Arthur Spindler, were against any attempt to take off and the Irish Free State air force authorities said it would be suicide to attempt a start under such conditions with even worse prospects as the flight progressed. The flight was then postponed until tomorrow at the earliest.

A steam roller lumbered up and down the long stretch of ground beyond the wooden runway, ironing out the soggy ground so the five-ton burden would not sink into the turf at the start of its venture.

The fliers had breakfast at 4 with the German consul general and other members of the Dublin German community, and made the eight-mile trip to the airfield despite the weather.

Irish weather experts believe that the Atlantic weather is likely to delay the flight for several days at least, unless Baron von Huenefeld insists on starting.

"Third—electric power control in the interests of the people, and not for the benefit of a few politicians."
