Oregon Rank Is Second In Use Of Forest Area

Oregon ranks second and Washington fifth in the recreation use of the national forests...

The forest service data are the best estimates possible for them to secure and visitors are listed under such headings as hotel and resort guests, campers, picnickers...

For the 38 states (and Alaska) in which there is a total of 159 national forests, the estimated total number of visitors for 1927 was 13,523,859.

Of these, California reports 7,044,518; Oregon 2,944,990; Colorado 2,162,173; Arizona 1,269,159; and Washington 1,125,518.

The 190 national forests of Alaska report 45,550, of which 16,000 were traveling in automobiles and 2,100 on foot.
