CHICAGO, Apr. 7 (AP)—Opening unchanged to 1/2 cent off, wheat soon rose all around to above Thursday's finish. Corn, oats and provisions also were stronger, corn starting 1/4 to 3/8 up and subsequently holding near to the initial range.

Wheat closed firm, 1/4 to 1/2 net higher, corn 1/4 to 3/8 up, oats varying from a shade decline to 1/4 to 3/8 advance, and provisions unchanged to a rise of 1/8.

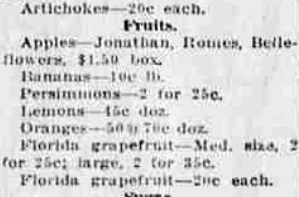

Butter Prices Drop Sharply In Portland Market

PORTLAND, Ore., Apr. 7 (AP)—Butter prices dropped sharply during the week with the average decline about 3 to 2 1/2c per pound on all grades. Today's quotations were unchanged from yesterday but indications are that further recessions will take place in the first part of next week.

Egg values likewise eased a trifle all around but the drops were small and feeding in the market is that the bottom has been reached for the season. Storage holdings at the close of the market yesterday were reported at 22,981 cases. Poultry prices held firm throughout the week with heavier hens and broiler stock strong and in light supply. During the last few days some accumulation of leghorn hens was noticeable and the prices shaded downward a trifle.

Country dressed meats showed little change during the week except for lamb, which advanced about 2c occasioned by first arrivals of spring lambs on the market with consequent increase in demand all around. Quotations were steady today.

Y., where he was born almost 54 years ago, was prepared to receive his body after services in St. Thomas' Episcopal church here. Merchants in the village agreed to suspend business while the cortege passed through the streets.

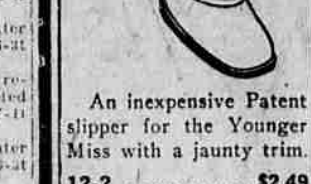

CANTON, Apr. 7 (AP)—Advice from the Yreochum and Young-kour districts 140 miles south of Canton today said that inhabitants had been massacred by reds who were in control there.

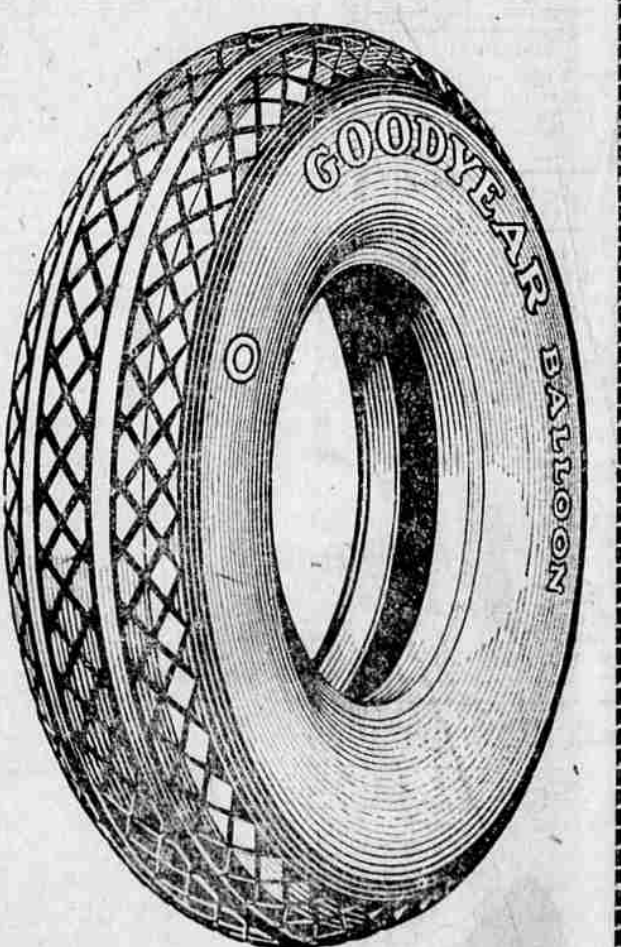
Three thousand extremists captured the cities and set them afire. All males more than 40 years old were slain, women defamed and infants burned.
