Old Age Disease Is Made the Subject Of Intensive Study

NEW YORK, May 7 (AP)—The New York Academy of Medicine announces a two weeks program on the problems of old age to be conducted in this city beginning October, for the benefit of the physicians of the country. Lectures, bedside talks and courses in hospitals and clinics here will stress the prevention of premature aging and will pay special attention to diseases of the heart and kidneys and affections of blood pressure.

The gathering of medical men will be the academy's first "Annual Graduate Fairnight." By concentrating all available knowledge and experience on a single problem each year, with meetings thrown open to practitioners, sponsors of the movement believe that unusual opportunities for study can be placed before the practicing physician.

Men of international repute will lead the symposium of old age. The subjects to be discussed include general management in old age, bronchitis and asthma, joint diseases, liver and biliary passages, the aging myocard, angina pectoris and hypertension, surgical problems in old age, nose, throat and ear diseases in the aging patient, diet and body weight, hypertension, nephritis and old age, and the use of alcohol in old age.

Among the speakers are Dr. Samuel W. Lambert, president of the academy; Dr. Charles F. Collins, New York; Dr. Frederick T. Lord, Harvard medical school; Dr. Russell L. Ford, Cornell medical school; Dr. Franklin W. White, Boston; Dr. Alfred Cohn, Rockefeller Institute; Dr. Harlow Brooks, New York University medical college; Dr. John J. Moorhead, New York Post Graduate medical school and hospital; Dr. Arthur B. Ducl, Manhattan Eye, Ear and Throat hospital; Dr. Solomon Sarnau, Northwestern University medical school, Chicago; Dr. Herman O. Mosenthal, New York Post Graduate medical school and hospital; and Dr. Nellis B. Foster, Cornell medical school.

 SALEM, Ore., May 11 (AP)—The monthly report of the Clare A. Lee, state insurance commissioner, relative to April fire losses shows that the loss outside of Portland was \$259,547, and the total number of fires was 75.
