

STUDEBAKER HAS ALL A. A. MARKS

Fully Equipped Stock Car Records Are Held by Corporation

All American Automobile association records for fully equipped stock cars are now held by Studebaker. Never before has one manufacturer thus swept the boards.

Studebaker holds not only the open car records but the closed car records also. Regardless of power or price of car, open or closed, the highest record for every distance from 1 to 25,000 miles, and from one hour to 24 hours is held either by the Studebaker Commander or by the Studebaker President.

All Studebaker records were made with stock cars, fully equipped even to the extra tire. The only records not now held by Studebaker were made with stock cars stripped of windshields, fenders, running boards, etc., for racing.

In addition to holding the Commander and President all the highest records for fully equipped stock cars regardless of power or price, Studebaker holds with the Delator and Erskine the highest records in their respective price classes.

The records of the Commander were made in October and November, 1927, and far exceed any other in the history of transportation.

Two Commander roadsters ran 25,000 miles in less than 23,000 consecutive minutes, establishing 37 intermediate records. Nothing else

on earth ever ran so far so fast. A Commander sedan at the same time traveled 25,000 miles in less than 23,000 consecutive minutes, setting 28 intermediate records. A President eight five-passenger sedan last month set out to win all the records for fully equipped closed cars not already held by the Commander.

On April 22-23 at the Atlantic City speedway it completed 2000 miles in 1644 minutes. The average speed for the entire distance was 73.525 miles per hour. This performance of the President shattered the former record for fully equipped stock closed cars for every distance from five to 2000 miles and for every period from one to 24 hours. The 24-hour closed car record—formerly held by a 14000 automobile—was beaten by an average of more than four miles per hour. In all, 32 closed car records fell to the President—giving Studebaker a clean sweep of everything in the field of fully equipped stock cars.

The President's achievement was the third record-breaking performance of Studebaker cars during April.

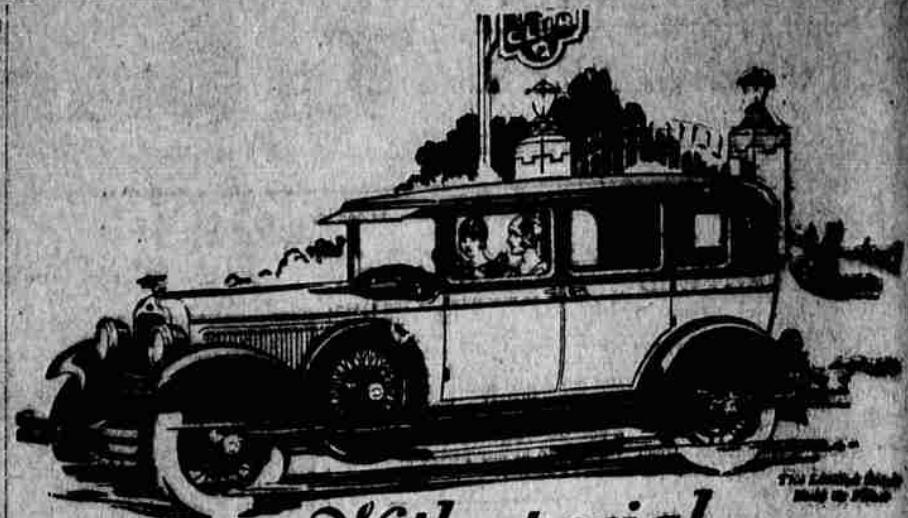

W. E. Buchanan, of the Weeks

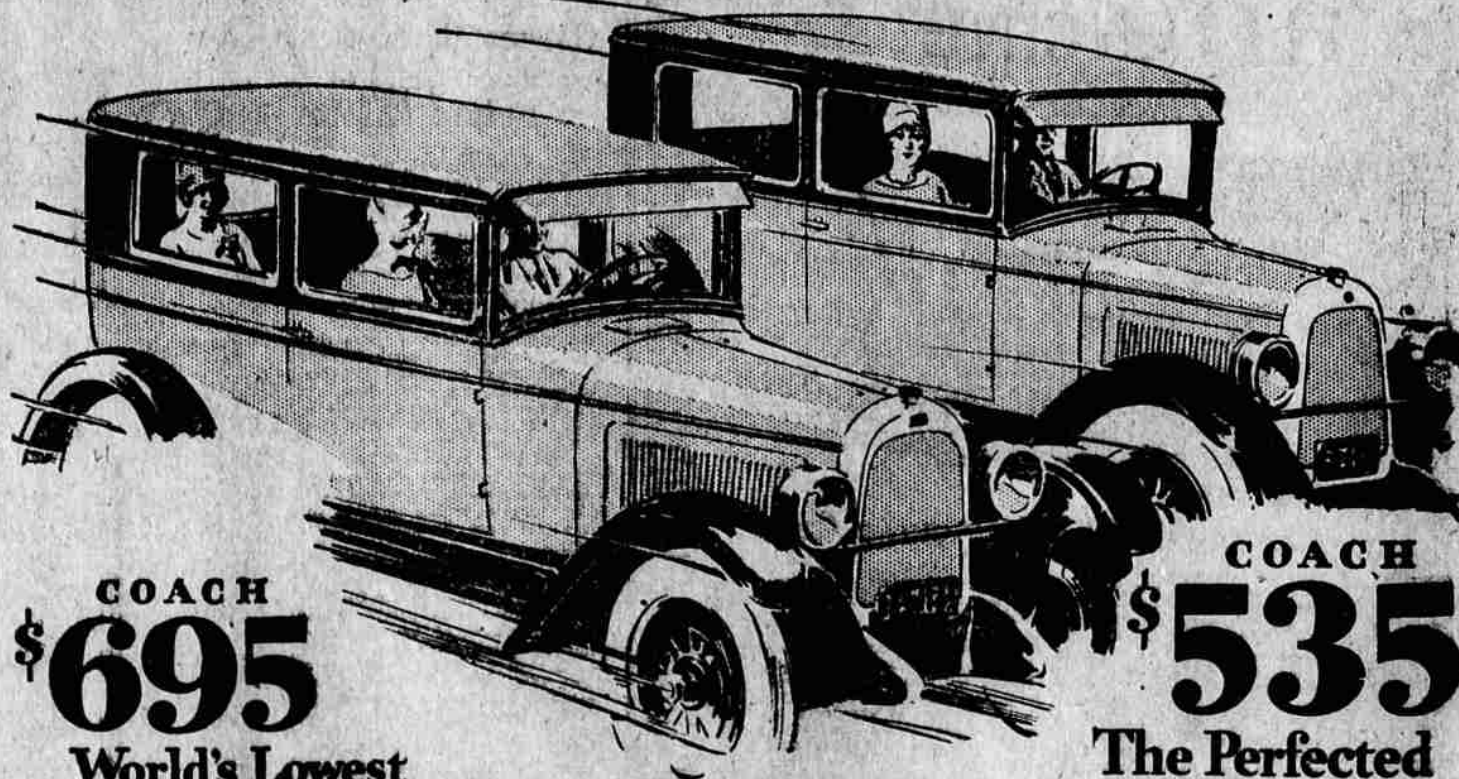
