Babies' Bow-Legs Normal, M. D. Says

MINNEAPOLIS, Minn., June 15 (AP)—Parents shouldn't worry if the baby is bow-legged and knock-kneed when he learns to walk, for the legs of every normal infant get that way when they are first used.

This was the counsel given today by Dr. Clifford Sweet of Oakland, Cal., in a paper read to the section on children's diseases of the American Medical association. When a baby first begins to stand upright, Dr. Sweet pointed out, his principal object is to attain stability and is therefore dependent on a wide base. Hence it is that he stands with his knees together and his feet far apart; but as his muscles coordinate he walks like an adult. A well-fitting shoe, in Dr. Sweet's opinion, is of great importance to toddlers. He also urged that every infant be allowed to go barefoot part of each day.
