Talk of 6 and 7 Per Cent Money Bothers Street

NEW YORK, July 24 (AP)—Aggressive pool operations in a select assortment of specialties turned the course of stock prices upward again today after an early period of irregularity. A "bear" drive against several of the popular industrial in the morning trading quickly petered out when it was discovered that relatively little "long" stock was being disclosed.

Call money was in fairly plentiful supply at the renewal rate of 5 1/2 per cent, although higher money is expected late in the week. Banks called about \$10,000,000 in loans during the morning. Talk of 6 and 7 per cent call money continues to have a restrictive effect on trading.

The closing was irregular. Railroad shares were strong in final dealings, gains of 1 to nearly 3 points being marked up by Canadian Pacific, Chesapeake and Ohio, New York Central, Wabash and Great Northern, but Pittsburg and West Virginia took an opposite course, losing 7 points. Case Threshing dropped 5 points.

Total sales approximated \$3,000,000 shares.

MEDIUM EGGS GO INTO CENT SLUMP

Peaches Bring 80 Cents to \$1 a Box in Portland Market

PORTLAND, Ore., July 24 (AP)—Both grades of medium eggs were a cent lower on wholesale markets this morning. Extras were quoted today at 26c and medium flats at 25c per dozen. Although receipts of eggs were light yesterday at 452 cases, demand was slow and over 300 cases went into storage.

Butter and butterfat quotations were steady today with demand fairly well maintained. Yesterday's receipts were 11,974 pounds.

Pork was a trifle firmer at 19c per pound on the country dressed meat markets, reflecting sharp price upturns at the North Portland yards yesterday. Offerings of choice light hogs were moderate. Other classes of country killed meats were in fair supply at steady prices.

Poultry prices were likewise firm with heavier classes of hens still in light supply. Broilers were plentiful.

Blackcap and red raspberries were fairly plentiful but rather ripe and hardly suitable for shipment although in good condition for immediate consumption. Prices ranged from \$1.50 to \$2.

Peaches were bringing 80c to \$1 per box on the early market, with quality of offerings fairly good. Some desirable Elberta peaches are expected in from California next week.

New Gravenstein apples from California were in and going to the trade at \$2.75 per box. They were of fairly good color but a trifle green. Apricots were selling at 75c to \$1.25 per box this morning.

Tomatoes were not overly plentiful and went as high as \$3 per box for best Walla Walla offerings.

Potatoes were steady, new whites going at 1 1/2c per pound, while best Deschutes gems, of the old crop, brought \$1.50 per sack.

CHICAGO, July 24 (AP)—Opening 1/4 to 1/2 higher. Chicago wheat afterwar secured decided further gains. Corn, oats and provisions were easier, with corn starting 1/2c to 1 1/2c off and subsequently holding near to the initial figures.

Corn closed nervous, 1/2 to 3/4c net lower, wheat at 1 1/2 to 2 1/2c advance, oats unchanged to 1/2c off and provisions unchanged to 18c decline.
