"GIRL HICKMAN," 17, SHOWS NO GRIEF AFTER KILLING YEAR-OLD BABY

By NEA Service OAKLAND, Cal.—"The girl Hickman" is the title police here have bestowed on Miss Erna Janoschek, 17-year-old high school girl who is being held on charges of first degree murder.

Erna, a rather pretty, intelligent young flapper, struggled to death a year-old baby, Diana Lillencrants, for whose parents Erna worked as a maid and nurse. She told about it with flip unconcern.

"I strangled the baby because I felt her mother wasn't supporting me in managing her other child, and because I felt they were working me too hard."

At this point the girl interrupted her explanation to laugh. "I have to laugh when the impulse comes over me," she said. "When things like this happen I have to laugh."

Which remarks help to explain why the police call her "the girl Hickman."

Some criminologist here see an amazing similarity between Erna and the young Los Angeles murderer.

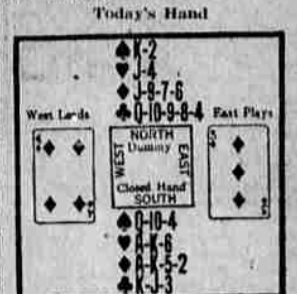

Soviet Rescue Ship Ordered To Move Into North

MOSCOW, July 25 (AP)—The soviet rescue commission today ordered the icebreaker Sedov, now in Arctic quarters, to explore the region around Franz Joseph land and to push in a northwesterly direction in search of the missing Amundsen group...

The icebreaker Malign anchored this morning off Archangel after returning from an unsuccessful search for the still missing men.

The rescue ship Krasin, which picked up seven of the Italia's crew, including the Viglieri group off Poyan island, is sailing for Stavanger, where it will be overhauled.

The rescue commission intends to send by airplane from Leningrad a new chassis and other spare parts for Pilot Chukhovskiy's plane. Then the icebreaker will renew its search.
