WHOLESALE MARTSpuds Draggy at Steady
Prices—Peaches Are
in Oversupply

PORTLAND, Ore., July 26 (AP)—Eggs were decidedly weaker on local wholesale markets with all grades off from 1c to 1 1/2c per dozen. Standard firsts took the largest decline, falling 1 1/2c to 27c per dozen. Other grades declined 1c per dozen.

Except for an advance of 1/2c on cube standards, butter quotations were steady today.

Potatoes were draggy at steady prices, but onions were easier with the top on most desirable Walla Walla yellow globes around \$1.50. Less desirable kinds were down as low as \$1 per cwt.

County dressed meat and poultry markets were quiet with receipts and trading both limited. Quotations were unchanged.

Lemon values continued soaring on the wholesale market with fancy offerings bringing as high as \$10 per crate. Oranges were about steady at yesterday's figures with the top around \$2 per crate. California grape fruit sold as high as \$5 per case.

California peaches were also in oversupply this morning, ordinary quality stuff going at 65c per case, while real fancy ones brought from 90c to \$1. Some large fancy J. H. Hale peaches arrived from California today and were being quoted at \$1.25 to \$1.40 per crate for low and large.

Apples were a-begging on the early market with supplies more than double the small demand. Dealers were getting from 85c to \$1 for 25 pound bins while the small bins went mostly at 50c to 75c.

The Dallas tomatoes were quoted at \$2.25 per 25 lb. bin, while Walla Walla offerings brought as high as \$4.50.

CHICAGO, July 26 (AP)—Opening at 1 1/2 to 2c decline, Chicago wheat values afterward recovered somewhat. Corn, oats and provisions were easy. Prices for corn started at 1 1/2c off to 1/2c up and then sagged all around but subsequently rallied.
