EGG VALUES ARE HIGHER; CORN UP

Wholesale Fruit and Vegetable Markets Quiet, Prices Weak

Portland, Ore., July 31 (AP)—Egg values were higher today on local wholesale markets. All grades advanced a full cent except standard extras, which were 5c higher at 29c. Demand for eggs was active yesterday and receipts light at 251 cases. Storage holdings were 31,141 cases.

Trading was more active on country dressed meat markets. Receipts were heavier today in all classes and prices were generally steady to weak.

Wholesale fruit and vegetable markets were more than usually quiet and prices were generally steady to weak.

Yellow corn was higher at around \$1.75 per bushel of six dozen ears. White corn was about steady at \$1.62 1/2 per bushel.

Yakima noted good potatoes, new stock, were on the market today and sold readily at \$1.75 per sack. Old stock, 12-8 No. 1 grade sold at \$1.41 1/2.

Walla Walla yellow globe onions were steady around \$1.41 1/2 per sack.
