SAYS CHURCH NO PLACE FOR SMITH DEBATE

NEW YORK, Aug. 12. (AP)—The Rev. Dr. John Hensch Stratton, Pastor of Calvary Baptist church, has refused to meet Governor Smith in debate in his church on the grounds that the pulpit is no place for a political discussion.

Governor Smith had asked to be allowed to defend himself there from the attack Dr. Stratton made on him from the pulpit of Calvary a week ago Sunday in which the governor in debate in the pulpit bested foe of moral progress in the country.

Dr. Stratton's refusal to meet the governor in debate in the pulpit from which he made his charges was made in a statement read to the congregation in Calvary last night by his son, the Rev. William Stratton, of Philadelphia, who conducted the evening service in the absence of his father who is at his summer home in Greenwood Lane, N. Y.

"I stand ready to meet the governor at any time except the Lord's day, and in any suitable place," Dr. Stratton wrote, "and I sincerely hope that he may be led to take my acceptance of his challenge at its face value."

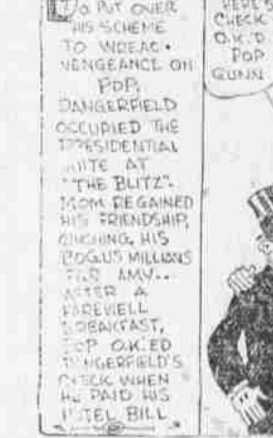
