Major league contenders are finding it difficult, not to say impossible, to pull away from one another what with the Braves and the Phillies plunging into their annual fall wreathing campaign several weeks ahead of schedule.

The Cardinals had a grand opportunity to do something handsome for themselves when the Giants lost again in Chicago yesterday but the humble Braves were in there pummeling the Cards.

This continuation of events left the margin of the St. Louis team still three and one-half games in the lead McGraw moved into the ground city for a three-day crucial series.

**American League Leaders Wilt**

### Swim Endurance Record Broken By Mrs. Fourrier

COLTON, Cal., Aug. 17, (AP)—Like a feat of arms, for an educational advertisement reads the story of Mrs. Leo Fourrier.

Three years ago she could not swim a stroke. Today the gritty 26-year-old mother holds for the second time, the world's endurance swim record—this time at a mark of 26 hours, 30 minutes, 30 seconds.

That record, made when she walked unassisted from the Colton municipal plume yesterday afternoon, eclipsed by two hours 25 minutes 20 seconds the time set in New York recently by Mrs. Myrtle Handless of Matson, Ill.

**Collapse Follows Swim**

Although Mrs. Fourrier finished as she had said she would—without need of assistance in leaving the plume, she collapsed soon afterward. She was rushed to her home in an ambulance and within an hour was unconscious from sheer exhaustion. Her physician said her condition was not serious, however.

She had weighed 152 pounds when she started her record-breaking swim and she weighed 154 when she finished. She had breath, coffee and lemon sugar frequently during the long and weary paddle about the outdoor pool.

Six weeks ago Mrs. Fourrier collapsed after her forty-sixth hour of swimming in her first record swim. The mark she set then was bettered after standing only a few hours by Mrs. Handless. The latter boosted her own mark in a later try and it was this record which Mrs. Fourrier yesterday smashed.

Mrs. Fourrier was one of the last women forced out of the famous William Wrigley Jr. \$25,000 swim across Santa Catalina channel two years ago, and since has participated in long distance swims on the Pacific coast.

NEW YORK, Aug. 17, (AP)—James J. Tunney, private citizen, formerly Gene Tunney, heavy weight champion of the world, is on the high seas today bound for Europe for his projected walking tour with Thornton Wilder, novelist, Gene, as "Theodore" as any other private citizen, sailed yesterday aboard the Mauretania.

**Tunney Impatient**
