CONTRACT BRIDGE
Continuing today our series of Friday and Saturday Contract and Auction Bridge hands, No. 4 is given below. Readers are urged to make up their minds how they would bid and play it before they read the description that follows:

Bridge hand diagram showing cards for North and South in various suits.

Auction Bridge Bidding
South bids No Trump, followed by three passes.
Contract Bidding
South three No Trumps, followed by three passes or south three No Trumps, North four No Trumps, South five Clubs, North five Spades, South six No Trumps.
