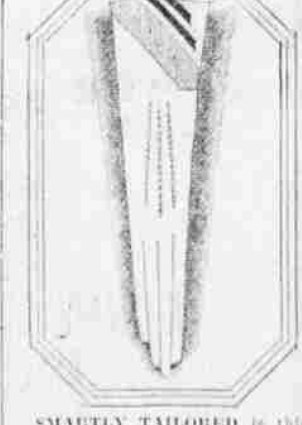

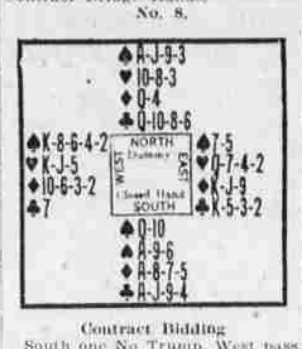

Contract Bidding

South one No Trump, West pass, North two No Trumps, East pass, South three No Trumps. The Dealer, with a count of 15, is two points short of the strength and justifies a bid of two No Trumps.

Auction Bridge Bidding

South one No Trump, followed by three passes. West leads the Four of Spades, Dummy plays the Ten, East the Seven and South the Queen.
