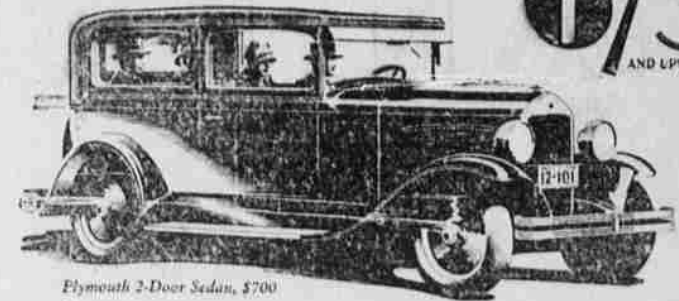
## Improvements In Cars Add Safety

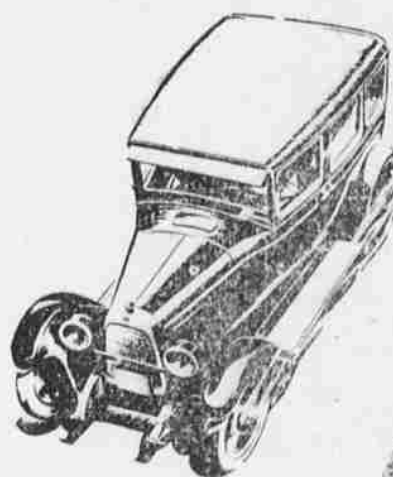

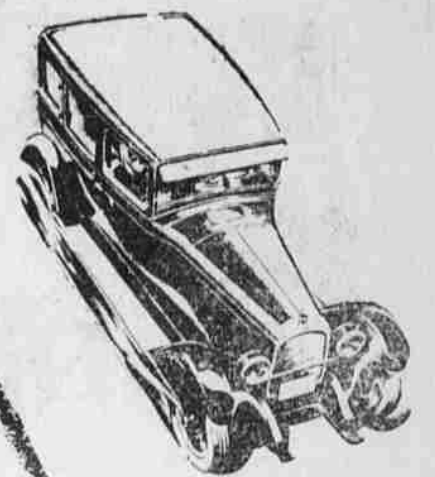
