The whirlwind season and barrage of hits that closed the schedule of the league yesterday and did nothing about untangling the deadlocked Solons and Senators at the top of the pile, starting Saturday at Sacramento, the two teams battle for the second half championship. The second game will be at San Francisco Sunday, and if a third is necessary it will be at Sacramento Monday. Should the Senators win the second half championship, they will have a better chance of winning the 1928 championship.

The two leaders showed themselves of championship caliber yesterday. The Solons downed Los Angeles in a barrage of 21 hits, 10 runs, 2 while Sacramento took the count of Seattle 16 to 2, shelling

three Indian pitchers for 20 outs.
