CARDS WELCOMED ON RETURN HOME

Oregon State and Trojans Fighting in Conference Game in L. A.

LOS ANGELES, Oct. 6 (AP)—Seldin in the past has so much been in the balance in an initial game as was seen in the University of Southern California's first start in Pacific coast conference play today against 11 star-wart Beavers from the Oregon State college.

With the necessity of the hearty tackle with the same Beavers last year and a name dragged from the fire with a one-point lead, Schissler within the walls of Troy have said, "we must whip the Oregonians soundly if the Pacific coast are to be ours this year."

Beaver Squad Heavy. The Utah Agricultural college game last Saturday—"A warming-up scrimmage," according to operators before it was played, but "A good test" upon the same authority, after it was over—caused the Trojan coaches to make a second guess about certain first string players and was believed to have been the cause of the transformation of Captain Jesse Hilde, 1927 all-American tackle, to an end position on offensive plays.

Led by Howard Maple, who carried an impressive niche in conference circles for himself last year at quarterback, the Beaver squad as it lined up today for its first conference game was among the heaviest in the coast.

SACRAMENTO, Oct. 6—(AP)—Tied for honors, San Francisco's Senators and the Sacramento Seals today will open a three-game series to determine the winner of the second half of the Pacific coast league's split season. Tomorrow the teams will meet in San Francisco and if a third game is necessary, it will be played here on Monday.

The Seals won the first half of the season. If they nose out the Senators for the second half they will pocket a \$15,000 bonus set up by the league. In case Sacramento wins the second half, the four teams will meet in a seven-game series, splitting the bonus 50 per cent to the winner and the balance to the loser.
