(Continued from Page 1) at the bank where Parker was an official. The youth was accused of forging checks, but because he was under 25, obtained probation.

Manhunt Ends in Oregon A manhunt started for the hoodlumper, but then known as Hickman, which ended at Pendleton, Ore., on Dec. 23.

Hickman at first pretended insanity. Then he admitted the crime. At his trial he pleaded "not guilty by reason of insanity" under

a new California law. Jerome Walsh, young Kansas City, Mo., lawyer was retained as chief counsel. The Los Angeles superior court jury found Hickman sane, sane guilty, as he admitted the facts alleged.

Courts Uphold Verdict The state supreme court sustained the verdict and the supreme court of the United States declined to review the case.

Wish then sought to have Warden James H. Hinchey of San Quentin prison delay the execution for a month hearing which he may die under the law if he believes it necessary. The warden declined to act.

Turned to Religion In his latter days Hickman sought solace in religion. He joined the Roman Catholic church. He issued a statement to the press a few days ago asking forgiveness and prayers and pointing out the error of living such a life as his. He was 21 years old at the time of execution.

Larger Postal Staff Is Sought To Check Bogus Security Sales

NEW YORK (AP)—The state department is seeking to check sales of fraudulent securities that have been obtained by the red of the postage stamp.
