APPLES MOVE IN NORMAL AMOUNT

Prices Unchanged in Butter and Egg List; Poultry Somewhat Mixed

PORTLAND, Ore., Oct. 31 (AP)—Movement of commodities on local markets was comparatively light in the early hours today with some attracting special notice.

Apples and pears moved in normal amounts, the former showing perhaps a little more activity on account of the opening of national apple week, but prices were unchanged from previous quotations.

Leftovers were sharply higher in the vegetable division, best stock from Eastern Washington potatoes reaching \$2.15 to \$4.45 per crate. Cauliflower was in abundant supply and showed in price from 75c to \$1.15 per crate.

Movement of potatoes was fair but there were no perceptible price changes. Most of the supply was of local and Yakima stock with a sprinkling of Deschutes County.

Prices were unchanged in the butter and egg list. Trading was active with shippers still eager to obtain top grades for shipment to New York.

Yesterday's receipts were: butter, 14,065 pounds; eggs, 394 crates. Storage buildings of eggs were 705 cases less than Monday at 22,042 and of butter, 4,426 pounds less at various points.

Poultry in the country division was somewhat mixed with heavy hens and springers cheaper and medium hens quoted 2c higher. Heavy hens were down a cent at 25c, springers and lighters were 2c lower at 22c and medium weight hens were 2c higher at 24c. Turkeys were under with prices ranging all the way from 20c to 30c on native fowls. Most stock was of independent grade and brought around 14c to 15c per pound, live weight.

Country dressed meat prices were steady, except for veal which was about a cent lower at 17c for top quality calves.
