"Freckles" Now Showing At The Arcade

Few are the cases wherein a motion picture director has taken a famous novel and brought it to the screen with the same spirit and atmosphere that the author intended it to have, but such a picture opens tonight at the Arcade Theatre. It is the late Gene Stratton-Porter's "Freckles," an FBO production directed by her son-in-law, Leo Meehan.

Without altering the action or the spirit, Meehan has taken Mrs. Porter's delightful tale and produced it on the screen correct in every detail.

One of the outstanding features of both the book and picture is its simple understanding of human nature.

The story is the tale of a young orphan, handicapped by the loss in childhood of one hand. Friendless, he overcomes the dangerous task of guarding the valuable Lumberport Forest. Through his bravery he becomes admired by the Bird Woman, a really lover, and her daughter, the Swamp Angel. Love quickly develops between Freckles and the Angel, and of course there is a happy ending.

"Across to Singapore" is by far the most gripping, realistic sea drama in many moons. James Mason is the sinister first mate, a character "heavy" role which he handles with exceptional skill, and Frank Currier and Edward Connelly contribute specially interesting bits of character work as the two old New England seafaring men. Alina May Wang plays a spectacular Oriental siren and Dan Wolheim and Duke Martin.
