Dorothy Cunningham is a royal figure as the queen-mother, and Edward Connelly renders an impressive performance as the prime minister. The comedy houses as to Maurice Cannon, a clever French actor who plays the king's valet, and Albert Vaughn, who plays a sprightly lady-in-waiting in the picture.
